The Tim Henman Foundation provides financial assistance in the form of grants to organisations where there is a high level of need.

Who we fund

Organisations based in England & Wales (charities, schools, hospitals/hospices) who provide benefits to disadvantaged children and young people (up to the age of 25) who are experiencing financial hardship, wider socio-economic issues, have a disability or are suffering from ill-health.



What we will fund:



Equipment - grants of between £1,000 - £10,000 for fully-funded specialist piece(s) of equipment that will enhance the lives of children and young people.

Capital projects - grants of between £5,000 - £20,000 towards facility improvements that will provide additional or new opportunities.

Other projects - at the trustees discretion.

We will prioritise grants:

- ✓ That demonstrate a high level of need.
- ✓ Organisations that are based in an area of deprivation.
- ✓ Who serve profoundly disadvantaged young people.
- ✓ And can clearly demonstrate benefits to young people and the wider community.

When to apply

We have two rounds of funding in the year:

Round 1: Applications open through June, followed by a trustee decision and September outcome.

Round 2: Applications open through January, followed by a trustee decision and March outcome.
